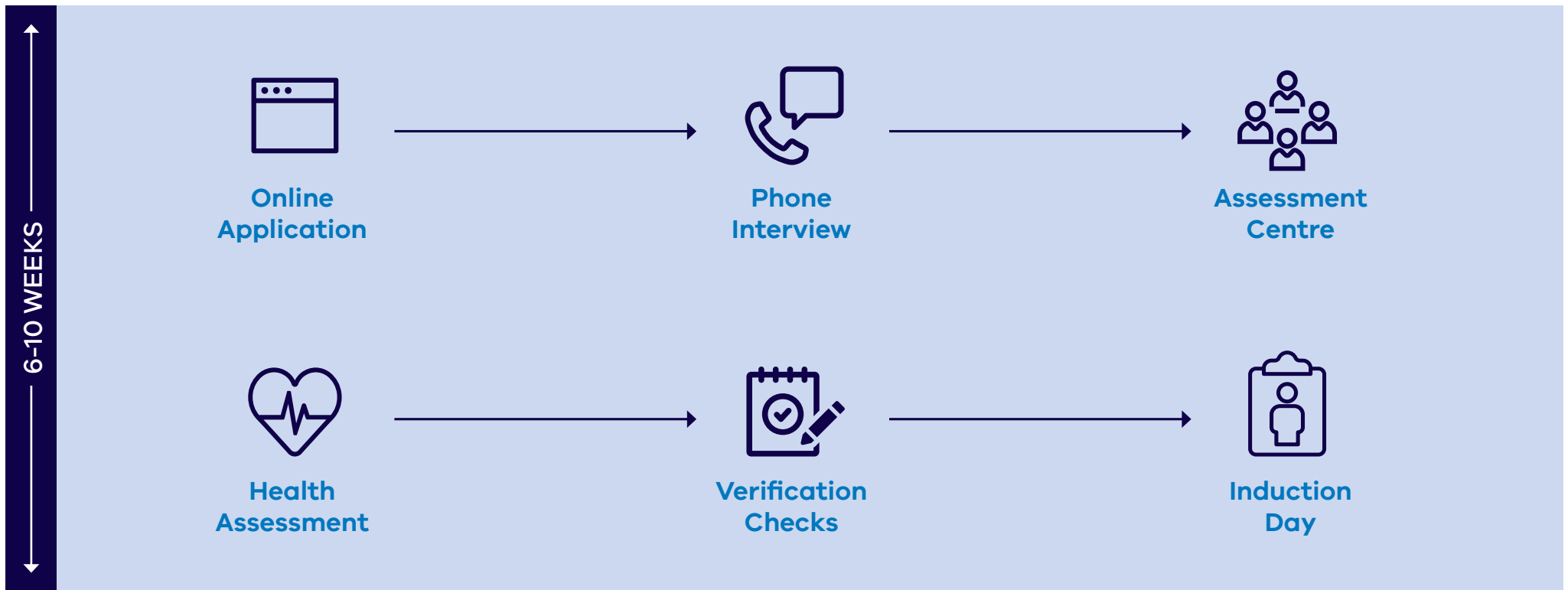

Prison Officer Recruitment Process

Put your skills to work with a career at Corrections Victoria

Complete these stages of the recruitment process to become a prison officer.

Remember to check your emails regularly as that is how we will communicate with you through the process.



Online Application

Tell us about yourself and your job history. Upload your resume and confirm your eligibility. Only one application is needed, even if you're interested in working at multiple locations.

⌚ 20 minutes – Online



Phone Interview

Describe your interest in the prison officer role in a short interview with a member of the recruitment team. It's a great chance to demonstrate your verbal skills. All you need to do is select a good time for us to call you

⌚ 10 minutes – via Phone



Assessment Centre

Participate in a role play, group activity and an online problem solving assessment. These activities will also give you an insight into the prison officer role.

⌚ 3 hours – Online or In person



Health Assessment

We will provide you with a free health assessment that will be completed by a third-party medical provider. Being fit for work is important and you can learn more about how to prepare for this stage by completing this short online [health assessment](#).

⌚ 3 hours – In person



Verification Checks

You'll be asked to complete pre-employment security checks. There's some online paperwork to fill-out with questions that will help to establish your suitability for the role. We will also connect with your referees, so it is a good idea to let them know in advance that you have applied to become a prison officer.

⌚ 20 minutes – Online



Induction Day

Successful candidates will be invited to an induction session where you meet other new team members, and we help get you started on your new career at Corrections Victoria.
